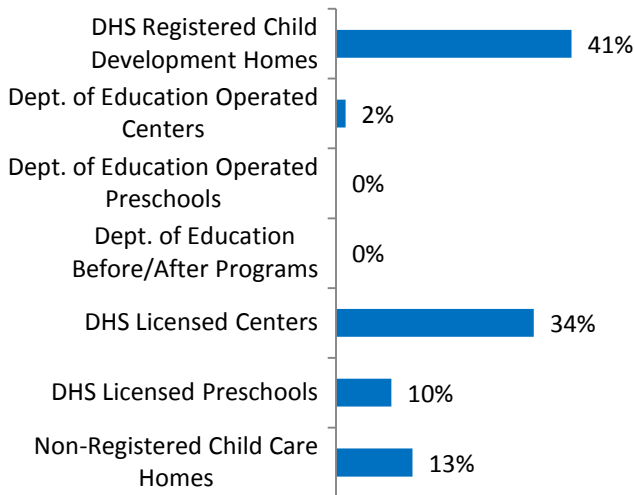

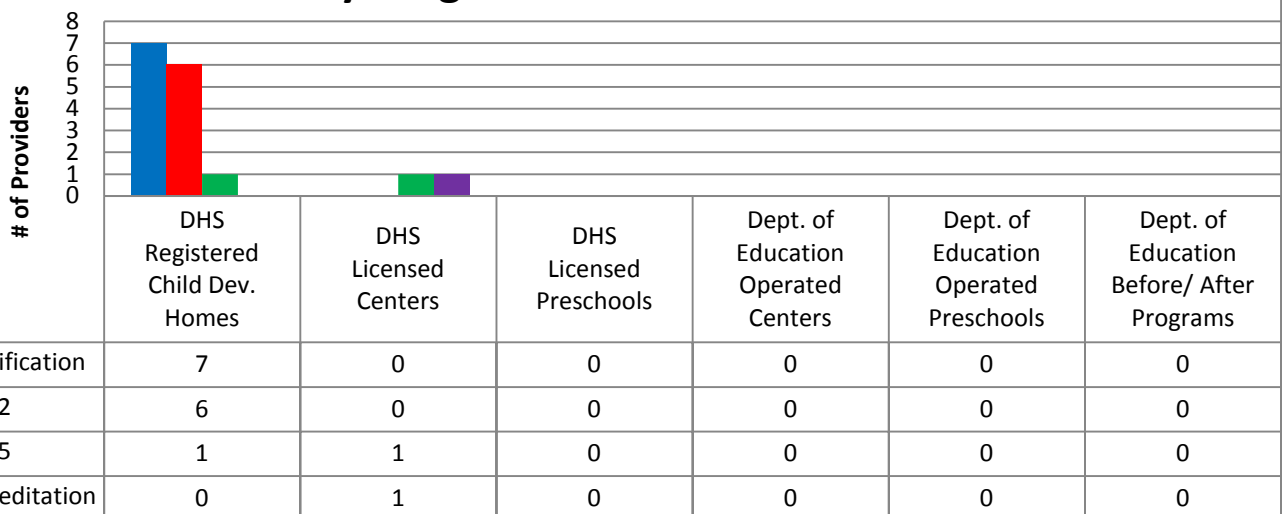

**For a family earning the median income of \$41,296 with an infant in child care they would pay:**

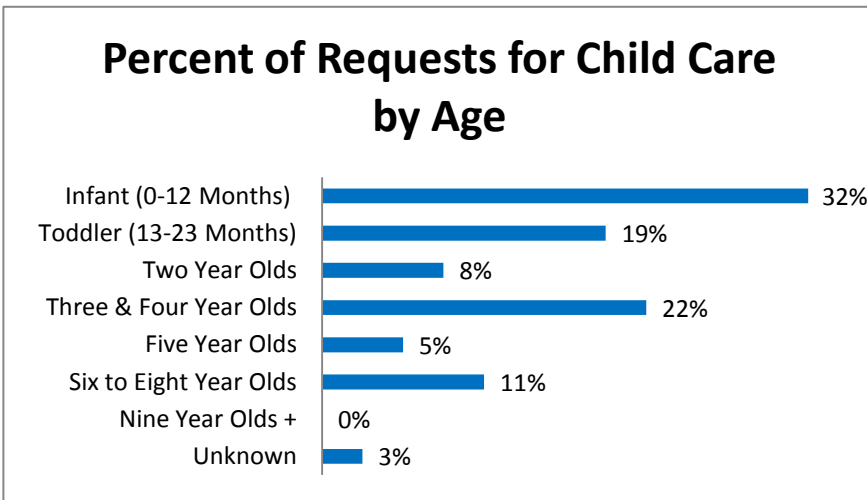
- 15% of their income before taxes, if their child was in a registered home

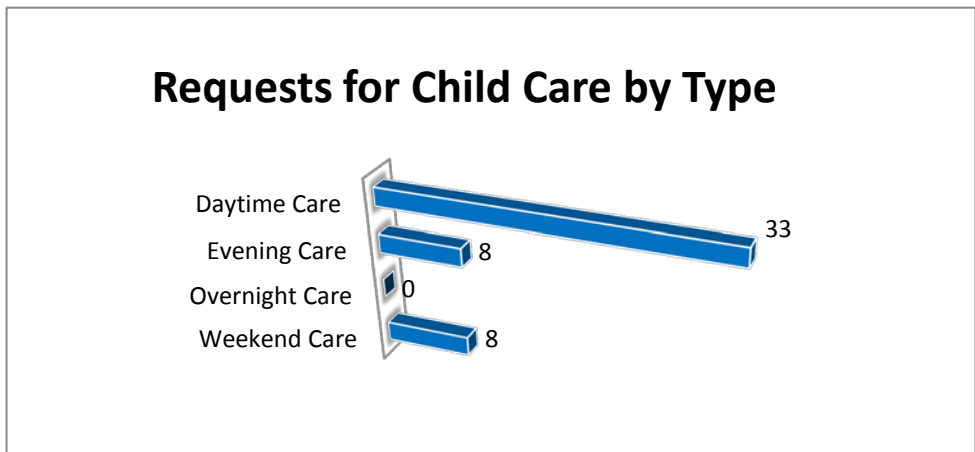
